



FOR THE ATTENTION OF STUDENTS WHO WILL TAKE ERASMUS LANGUAGE EXAM!

- 1) The exam named VERSANT will take place online via a link that is going to be sent to your student e-mail accounts.
- 2) You must use a computer in order to take the exam; a desktop or a laptop (devices with Windows and MAC operating system) can be used.
- 3) You need to have both a webcam and a microphone in order to take the exam. Otherwise, the system will not allow you to take the exam.
- 4) It is highly advised to use a headset with a microphone during the exam. If you are using a desktop computer, your computer may have two separate 3.5mm jack (aux) inputs for both a headphone and a microphone. In this case, you should use a microphone and a headphone with two jack outputs. Thus, you will be able to hear the questions and your speeches will be recorded for the exam at the same time. If your computer has an audio jack, you can use a headphone and a microphone with a single (shared) aux output.
- 5) It is of utmost importance to use Google Chrome as a web browser in order to take the exam. Otherwise, the system will not allow you to take the exam. Please make sure you have the latest version of Google Chrome installed on your computer.
- 6) During the stage where you check your System, if your internet connection is poor, please close the applications running in the background that may affect the internet connection and try connecting again. If this continues, please check your internet connection. By connecting with a different network, you can check the system again.
- 7) The VERSANT Test has 9 parts and takes approximately an hour.
- 8) When you finish the exam, be sure to click the "Finish" button. Otherwise, your exam result will not be calculated.
