**CALL FOR 2020-2021(\*) ERASMUS+ PROJECT STAFF MOBILITY**

**Announcement Date** : 04 Nov 2021  
**Application Period** : 26 Nov – 10 Dec 2021

**Staff Mobility contains 2 types of mobility:**

- Staff Mobility for Teaching (for Academic Staff)
- Staff Mobility for Training (for Academic and Administrative Staff)

**1. STAFF MOBILITY FOR TEACHING**

This activity allows HEI teaching staff or staff from enterprises to teach at a partner HEI abroad. Staff mobility for teaching can be in any subject area or academic discipline.

Full time or part time teaching staff employed by Yaşar University may undertake an Erasmus+ Staff Mobility for teaching. Mobility must be in a partner Higher Education Institution, which must have an ECHE (Erasmus Charter for Higher Education) and an inter-institutional agreement with Yaşar University (<http://erasmus.yasar.edu.tr/partners/>).

The amount of grant reserved to our university by the National Agency is 9.400 Euro for the 2020-2021 academic year. 8 teaching staff can be profited by mobility according to the agreement between the National Agency and our university.

**2. STAFF MOBILITY FOR TRAINING**

Erasmus+ training periods support the professional development of HEI staff. The training period may be in another HEI. Training periods abroad may be in the form of job shadowing, observation, attendance at workshops and international weeks. This may be for the transfer of knowledge and good practice, to learn from shared experience, acquire skills or discover new ideas for teaching and learning. Conference attendance isn't supported under training mobility.

The amount of grant reserved to our university by the National Agency is 9.300 Euro for the 2020-2021 academic year. 8 staff can be profited by mobility according to the agreement between the National Agency and our university.

**3. DURATION**

Mobility for teaching and training may be from 2 days to 5 days, excluding travel time. The individual must complete at least 8 hours for the whole period of teaching and the full day of training for each mobility day.

#### 4. ELECTION PERIOD

Applicants will be evaluated by “Erasmus Staff Mobility Committee” according to criteria you can see below.

**Besides, the committee considers subjects below while they are evaluating:**

- ✓ The topic must be within the teaching member's area of specialization
- ✓ Teaching member must have the language proficiency to be able to teach at the visited institution's medium of instruction
- ✓ Staff who is working on new cooperations for the Erasmus program

#### 4. STAFF MOBILITY GRANTS

Mobility grants (subsistence grant and travel grant) are provided by Erasmus+ for staff as contribution towards subsistence and travel.

The staff subsistence grant is to subsidize accommodation, meals and any in-country local travel. The value of the subsistence grants varies according to the host country and duration of mobility. The amount per day is calculated as follows and is set by the National Agency.

Before the mobility, 70% of the predicted amount of grant is paid to the staff.

The rest of grant is recalculated and paid after mobility and following to deliverance of documents below.

- **Teaching/Training Certificate (duly signed and stamped),**
- **Boarding passes or passport copies**
- **The online survey which is sended automatically by Mobility Tool system**

## 4.2 Staff Subsistence Grant

## 4.2 Staff Travel Grant

The staff travel grant is to cover return travel between Yaşar University and the host country. Staff travel grants are paid according to distance travelled, at the following rates:

Travel Distances	Amount (Euro)
Between 10-99 km	20 Euro
Between 100-499 km.	180 Euro
Between 500-1999 km.	275 Euro
Between 2000-2999 km.	360 Euro
Between 3000-3999 km	530 Euro
Between 4000-7999 km	820 Euro
8000 or more	1.500 Euro

## 5. OTHER INFORMATION

Staff who wish to participate to the program can waive financial support. In order to participate without a grant, the staff must apply in accordance with the principles provided in this information document and the application should be evaluated by the selection committee.

In addition to the standard grants received by the disabled beneficiaries participating in the Erasmus + Program, additional grants may be given to assist their specific needs. A special evaluation of each application makes by the National Agency and the National Agency decides whether an additional grant may be awarded and, if applicable, the appropriate amount of the grant.
