**CALL FOR ERASMUS+ STAFF MOBILITY
2022-2023 PROJECT YEAR**

Application Period : 03-18 Jul 2023

Staff mobility can be carried out from any Program Country to any other Program Country¹ or any Partner Country¹. To ensure high-quality mobility activities with maximum impact, the mobility activity has to be related to the staff's professional development and to address their learning and personal development needs.

Staff Mobility contains 2 types of mobility:

- Staff Mobility for Teaching -for Academic Staff only (Quota:8 person)
- Staff Mobility for Training - for Academic and Administrative Staff (Quota:9 person)

Staff Mobility for Teaching:

A teaching period abroad at a partner higher education institution. The teaching period abroad enables any teaching staff at a higher education institution or staff from enterprises to teach at a partner higher education institution abroad. Staff mobility for teaching can be in any study field.

Full time or part time teaching staff employed by Yaşar University may undertake an Erasmus+ Staff Mobility for teaching. Mobility must be in a partner Higher Education Institution, which must have an ECHE (Erasmus Charter for Higher Education) and an inter-institutional agreement with Yaşar University (<http://erasmus.yasar.edu.tr/partners/>).

Staff Mobility for Training:

A training period abroad at a partner higher education institution, enterprise or any other relevant workplace. The training period abroad enables any staff at a higher education institution to take part in a training activity abroad that is relevant to their day-to-day work at the higher education institution. It may take the form of training events or job shadowing.

Conference attendance isn't supported under training mobility.

A staff mobility period abroad can combine teaching and training activities.

Any teaching or training period abroad may be carried out as a blended mobility.

DURATION

Mobility for teaching and training may be from 2 days to 5 days, excluding travel time. The individual must complete at least 8 hours for the whole period of teaching and the full day of training for each mobility day.

APPLICATION

As of March 1, 2022, within the scope of the digitalization of the Erasmus+ program, application and selection procedures for Erasmus+ higher education student and staff mobility will be made via e-devlet login at <https://erasmusbasvuru.ua.gov.tr/giris?returnUrl=%2F>.

EVALUATION PERIOD

Applicants will be evaluated by “Erasmus Staff Mobility Committee” and according to criteria you can see below.

Besides, the committee considers subjects below while they are evaluating:

- ✓ The topic must be within the teaching member's area of specialization
- ✓ Teaching member must have the language proficiency to be able to teach at the visited institution's medium of instruction

STAFF MOBILITY GRANTS

Mobility grants (subsistence grant and travel grant) are provided by Erasmus+ for staff as contribution towards subsistence and travel.

The staff subsistence grant is to subsidize accommodation, meals and any in-country local travel. The value of the subsistence grants varies according to the host country and duration of mobility. The amount per day is calculated as follows and is set by the National Agency.

Before the mobility, 70% of the predicted amount of grant is paid to the staff.

The rest of grant is recalculated and paid after mobility and following to deliverance of documents below.

- **Teaching/Training Certificate (originally signed and stamped),**
- **Boarding passes or passport copies**
- **The online survey which is sended automatically by system**

Staff Travel Grant

The staff travel grant is to cover return travel between Yaşar University and the host country. Staff travel grants are paid according to distance travelled, at the following rates:

Travel Distances	Amount (Euro)	Green Travel Grant (Euro)
Between 10-99 km	23	
Between 100-499 km.	180	210
Between 500-1999 km.	275	320
Between 2000-2999 km.	360	410
Between 3000-3999 km	530	610
Between 4000-7999 km	820	
8000 or more	1.500	

Green travel is defined as the travel that uses low-emissions means of transport for the main part of the travel, such as bus, train or car-pooling.

OTHER INFORMATION

It is possible to benefit from the program by waiving the financial support. For participation without a grant, the staff must apply and the application must be evaluated by the selection committee.

Beneficiaries with disabilities participating in the Erasmus+ Program can be given additional grants to help their special needs in addition to the standard grants they receive. The special evaluation of each application is made by the National Agency and the National Agency decides whether additional grants can be given and, if applicable, the appropriate amount of grants.
